

STEWARDSHIP AT TRINITY...

With the first half of the year complete, it is a good opportunity to review Stewardship at Trinity so far in 2016 with you, the Trinity Family.

First we will discuss the income by quarter:

- Our income receipts for the 1st quarter of 2016 (January March over 12 Sundays) decreased 5.09% from the total received in the 1st quarter of 2015.
- During the 2nd quarter of 2016 (April June over 13 Sundays) our income receipts increased 1.35% over the income receipts during the 2nd quarter of 2015.

After it was reported that giving was down considerably in the first quarter, the council appreciates the response in the giving of our church family to turn the situation around and actually provide an increase in giving in the second quarter 2016 over giving in second quarter of 2015. The majority of the income receipts are made up of "Envelope Contributions", which after the significant decrease of 5% in first quarter giving, showed an overall decrease of only 2% total in 2016 at the close of second quarter. However, this decrease, coupled with a decrease in other income areas, such as Building Use, account for a decrease in overall receipts of 7.7%.

Unfortunately while giving has decreased, as presented in the budget, our expenses have increased in 2016. We approved a balanced budget for 2016 of our income and expenses. At the completion of 6 months of 2016, our regular income is nearly \$7,000 or 7.7% short of our budget projections. Please know Council does not feel these numbers are alarming, as we have faith in you, our Trinity Family; that you will continue to support our needs by sharing your time, offerings and talents. Please take this opportunity to review your current giving and to make important decisions about what you are willing and able to share to support Trinity and bring our budget into balance for this year.

As stated above, stewardship includes Time and Talents of each and every one of us. We are excited to see what God-given talents you will choose to bless Trinity with as we distribute and collect the annual Time and Talent sheets this year. There are many tasks involved with being a strong and faithful Church, and Council is confident that, just as in all of the years past, you will come forward with you talents to support the Church family. We appreciate each and every task that you have completed so far this year with generosity. Thanks be to God. STEWARDSHIP REMINDERS...

- Have YOU used your initial envelope? In each envelope packet was an Initial Offering Envelope that asked for a donation to offset the cost of printing and purchasing the envelopes. We are about \$148.00 short of our budgeted amount of \$415 to pay that cost. If you have not already, please consider utilizing this envelope with your donation.
- * One dollar in the loose offering each week DOES make a difference!
- Maintenance dollars are used to fund non-budget repair costs. (Monthly Maintenance Envelope is included in your set.) Every dollar you have given makes a difference! The Property Team is presently working on a repair and improvement list. <u>"Thanks for your continued support."</u>
