





Circle Drive Project Update – December 2018

On December 10th, a large concrete spreader poured all the concrete in one day! Now we wait 21 days for the concrete to cure. Thus, we hope to be able to park on the circle drive on Sunday, January 6, 2019.





While the concrete is curing, no vehicles can be on it. Thus, the electrician installing the three matching light posts will need to wait until 2019. These new light posts will have a LED light source; a future goal might be to replace the existing six lights on 8th Street with a LED light source also.

Back in 1997 when we did the major addition to our building, the folks in charge of that project hoped someday we would eventually replace the white trim of the breezeway to the brown aluminum used in other areas of our building. Council decided to go ahead and update the trim to the breezeway because maintenance needed to be done on the breezeway. Now the east side of the building will match other areas of our building.

We do have a few things we know cannot be completed until spring. To finish the final coat of painting on the canopy, the temperature needs to be just right. Of course the planting of grass will also be delayed.

We are thankful for all the 2018 donations and look forward to those gifts promised in 2019. The Mae Metzger estate is in the final stages of being closed; we anticipate her gift by the end of the year. To date we have not utilized the line of credit.
