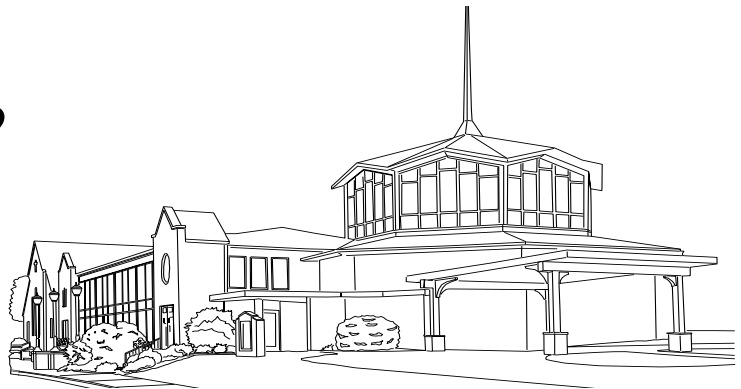

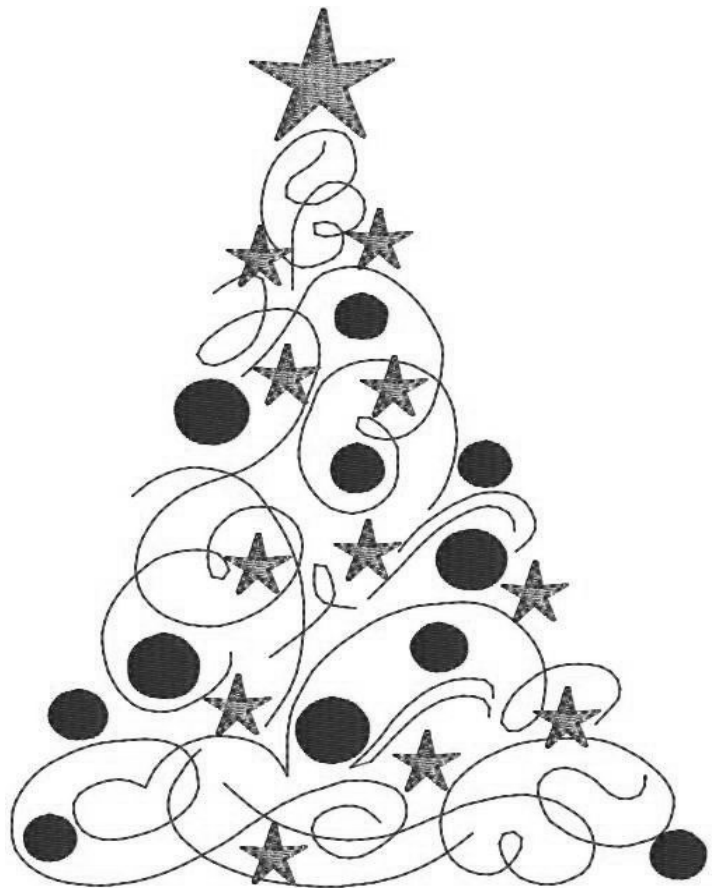

Council Highlights for November 2019

- Agreed to allow the neighbor (on the west side of the Parsonage property) to remove a tree at their cost. Most recently our Property Team had several trees removed at that time they also had all the other tree inspected and found no concern on any of the remaining trees.
- Agreed to allow rental of the building for Tai Chi classes.
- Set date for the annual meeting to be held **Sunday, February 2, 2020.**
- Agreed on a procedure to evaluate the pastor, which is requirement of the church's constitution. Previously this was done by the Pastor Relation Team. In a meeting at the UCC Synod our Pastor learned it not the job of Pastor Relation Team. So, it was decided council will perform this evaluation.

Note:

With changes happening since July of this year, serving in the leadership for our church has become extremely important. We need folks to step up to serve on ministry teams and church council. This coming year our pastor will be on sabbatical for three months. Even with the changes that took place in July, this will require more work of the leadership, because our Pastor is still doing a lot work.

At this moment, we don't know what pastoral coverage will look like. To fill in while the Pastor is gone, we may have three to four ordained and non-ordained clergy helping us; one clergy to be on call for funerals, one to lead worship, one for visitations to our shut-ins and another for the additional pastoral responsibilities. This will require a lot of effort in coordinating to keep our church going.

As I write this, we have two Council positions and many Ministry Team positions open. I am very thankful and rejoice for everyone doing the work of our church. I also realize we all are busy. Consider and pray on this verse from **Galatians 6:10: "Therefore, as we have opportunity, let us do good to all people, especially to those who belong to the family of believers"**
