








Back to School Celebration—Sunday, August 9 Worship 8:00 & 10:15 am

A lot of thought and care has brought about the decision to open the church to worship. We want to ensure you feel comfortable and safe in this crazy time of living within a pandemic.

- * Please exit the building promptly as this helps reduce your contact with others.


