Strassenfest is over and schools are in session. It is now time to get back into our regular routines as the fall begins. I am looking forward to the start of Sunday School, Confirmation, choir practice, the Women's Guild & Men's Fellowship, along with the continuation of worship, fellowship, service and outreach to others.

While the pandemic is still among us, I pray that the church and world will find ways to safely navigate these challenging times. We are fortunate, at Trinity, to have two worship opportunities and plenty of space to social distance. I encourage you to use your good judgement as to what is best for the health and safety of your family and your neighbors.

You may see me wearing my mask/shield in public for four reasons:

- 4. Faith & Science: I watch the positivity numbers for our area and follow the CDC recommendation of wearing a mask regardless of my vaccination status, especially since our children under 12 are not yet eligible for the vaccine.

I truly believe protecting the most vulnerable is at the heart of Christian living! May God give us strength & guidance as we love our neighbor as ourselves.

Highlights from the August 9, 2021 Meeting

August Decisions

- In a special meeting on July 26 a majority of the council approved the hiring of Taylor Kleinhelter as the Office Administrator, working 32 hours a week; she begins on 9/1.
- Approved the hiring of Technical Assurance a company specializing in finding water leaks in a building. (See update below!)

The middle of summer is quite busy behind the scenes at the church.

- Your budget team finalized a budget for 2022; it will go to Council in September.
- ➤ Council met in a special meeting to discuss additional compensation for a new Office Administrator.
- > Soon, the nominating team will meet to finalize a slate of candidates for our leadership.
- > Plus there are many emails that go back and forth on behalf of our church.

Financial Update: Currently, we are doing okay in our financials. There are some concerns as our giving stays flat/down and our expenses continue to increase and our budget shortfall continues to grow. We are on a path of using our capital reserves. We will most likely have some major cost with some anticipated work needing to be done in the sanctuary.

Update on Water leak in Sanctuary: Technical Assurance will be here August 19 and 20 to perform a series of tests to find the water leaks in the sanctuary dome. Once they are done with their testing, they will devise a plan to fix the problem. This fix could be expensive; the Council will call a special meeting once a plan has been developed.
