- Per request, approved a donation of \$500 to the Good Samaritan of Evansville, Indiana. We through the Lincolnland Association, support this facility.
- The agenda was confirmed for the Fall Annual Meeting. The meeting will cover two items, acceptance of the 2022 Budget and election of the new leadership for 2022.

This year, because of the growing number folks who are vaccinated, we will return to one service at 9 PM on Christmas Eve! Everyone is asked to wear face coverings (a face mask) regardless of your vaccination status or our county Covid status. Wearing a face mask is something that we feel is important because there may not be the ability to social distance properly.
